Penstemon Spires flowers rise from a mass of multicolored sweet potato vine in this intricate mix.

Light requirement: Sun

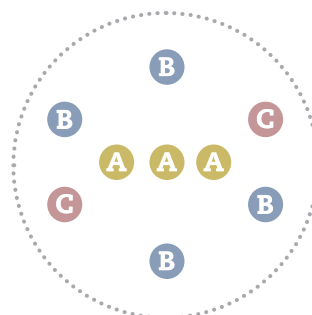
Pot size: 20 inches

- B. Tricolor sweet potato vine (4)
- C. Black Heart sweet potato vine (2)

Crimson Tidings

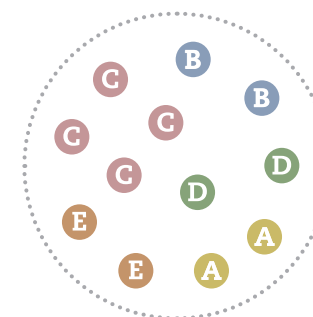
Red and purple are two of hummingbirds' favorite colors, making this container nearly impossible to resist.

Ingredients:

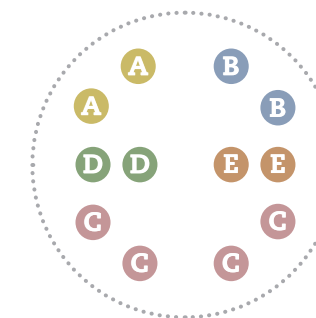
- A. 'Black Scallop' bugleweed (2)

- D. Superbena® Coral Red verbena (3)

Fuchsia

Fuchsia spp. • annual to Zone 8

Fuchsia's showy red, white, pink and purple blooms will capture your heart—and hummingbirds! Most plants are 6 to 24 inches high and grow best in partial shade.



Agastache

Agastache • Zones 5 to 11

This drought-tolerant perennial is the perfect addition to any wildlife habitat. Bushy and studded with blooms in summer, agastache comes in orange, pink, violet, yellow and blue and reaches 2 to 6 feet high.



Salvia

Salvia splendens • annual

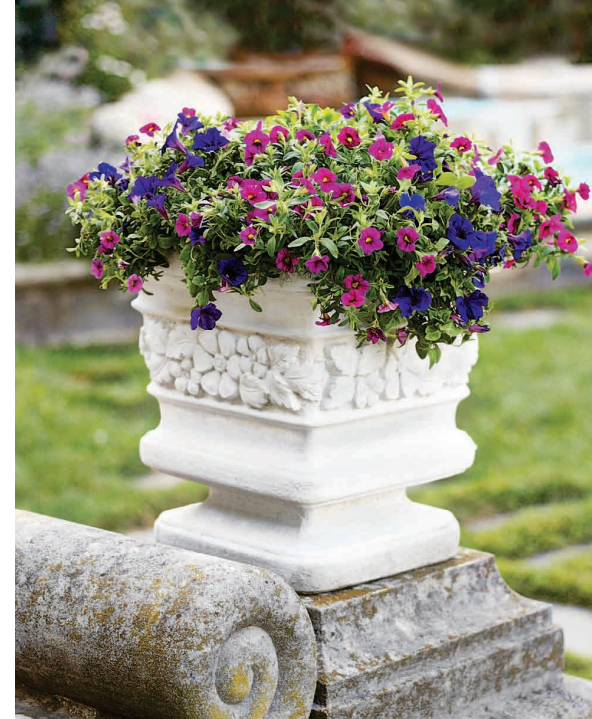
A true attention-getter, this spiky annual produces season-long color. Its vibrant columns reach heights of 8 to 24 inches. Bright colors, including red, enjoy bright spots; the pastel types like a bit of protection from the hot sun.



Cuphea

Cuphea llavea • annual

This sun-lover isn't just pretty, it's easygoing. Drought-tolerant cuphea boasts bright flowers on bushy plants that reach 18 inches tall. It prefers containers with plenty of growing room, so plant with that in mind.



Hummingbird Gems

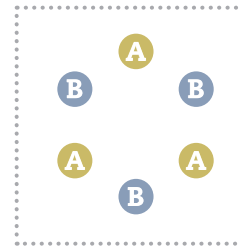
This jewel-toned pair's bell-shaped blooms advertise the tasty treats waiting inside.

Grand Finale

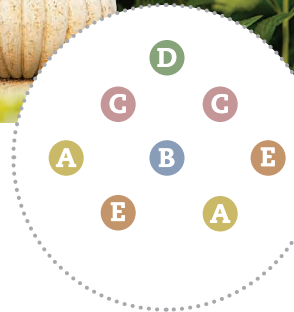
Spiky angelonia stands out against floss flower's soft tufts in this lofty purple-and-green masterpiece.
