


doughnut snowman



doughnut snowman


No need to bundle up to build this snowman! It's made of candy and doughnuts. Created by the Taste of Home Test Kitchen, this tasty wintertime project is fun for the entire family.

PREP/TOTAL TIME: 5 MIN. YIELD: 1 SNOWMAN, 3 SERVINGS

- 3 powdered sugar doughnuts (graduated sizes from 2 to 3 inches if possible)
- 1 powdered sugar doughnut hole or mini doughnut
- 5 mini chocolate chips
- 1 orange-mint Tic Tac
- 1 piece (10 to 12 inches) "fruit by the foot" fruit roll
- 3 gumdrops
- 2 pretzel sticks
- 1 starlight mint

On a small plate, stack the three doughnuts to form body of snowman. Place doughnut hole on top for head. Add chocolate chip buttons and eyes and an orange-mint nose.

Make 1-in. cuts on both ends of the fruit roll to form scarf fringe; wrap scarf around neck. Press a gumdrop onto each pretzel to form mittens; press pretzel arms into body. Top with a hat made from a mint and a gumdrop.



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
