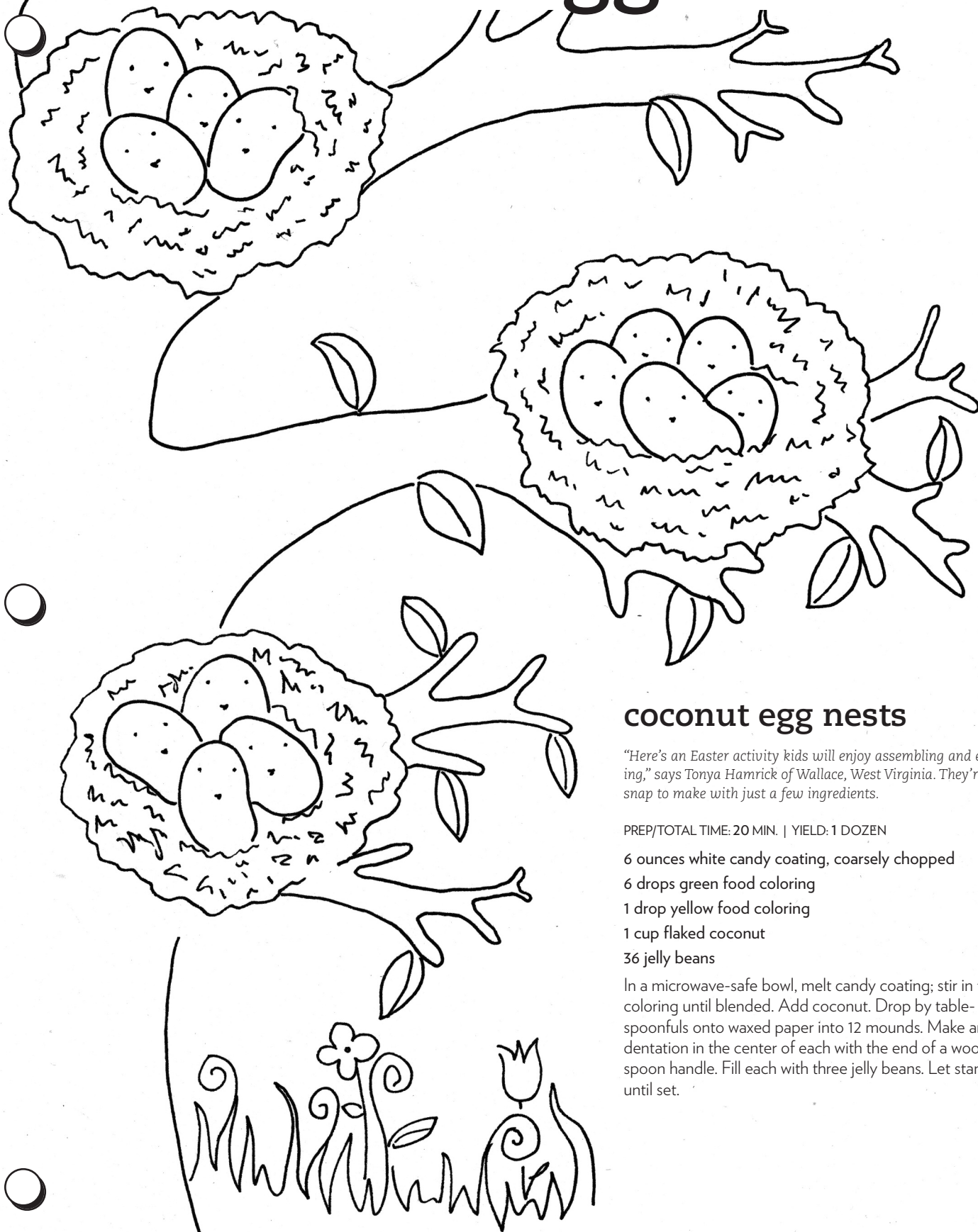


coconut egg nests



coconut egg nests

"Here's an Easter activity kids will enjoy assembling and eating," says Tonya Hamrick of Wallace, West Virginia. They're a snap to make with just a few ingredients.

PREP/TOTAL TIME: 20 MIN. | YIELD: 1 DOZEN

6 ounces white candy coating, coarsely chopped
6 drops green food coloring
1 drop yellow food coloring
1 cup flaked coconut
36 jelly beans

In a microwave-safe bowl, melt candy coating; stir in food coloring until blended. Add coconut. Drop by table-spoonfuls onto waxed paper into 12 mounds. Make an indentation in the center of each with the end of a wooden spoon handle. Fill each with three jelly beans. Let stand until set.
